

Foundation Day Memorial Speech: 2018

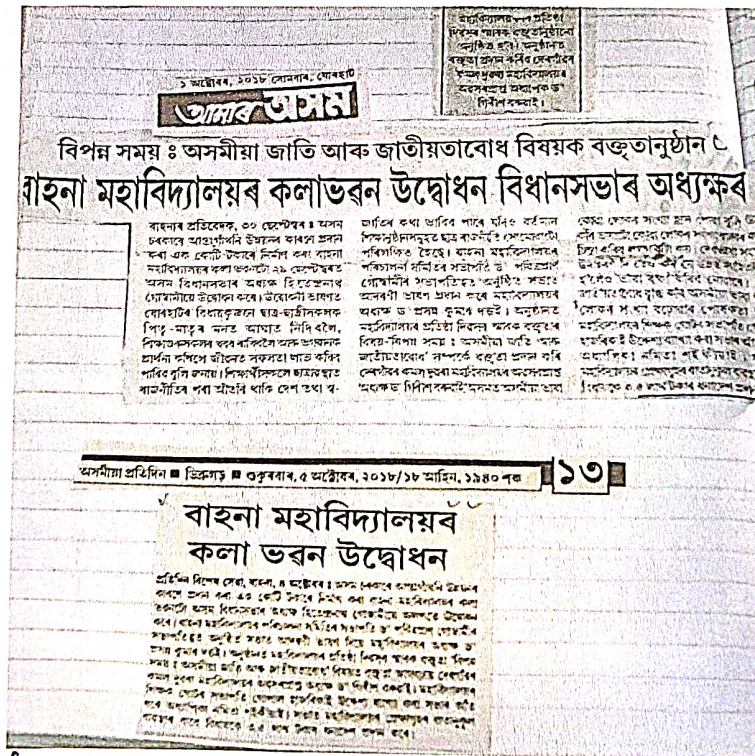
Date: 29th of September, 2018

On the occasion of the Foundation Day Memorial Speech of Bahona College, the New Arts Block of Bahona College was inaugurated on the 29th of September, 2018 by Hitendra Nath Goswami, speaker of Assam Legislative Assembly. The Arts Block was completed with the 1 crore provided by the Government of Assam for Infrastructural Development in Bahona College. In his speech, he urged the students to be responsible towards their parents, teachers and society as a whole. He also urged the students to work for the benefit of society even without associating themselves with active politics.

Mr Gopal Hazarika, President of Teachers' Unit Bahona College forwarded the agenda for the Lecture. The programme was hosted by Dr. Namita Chutiya Saikia. Dr. Pobitra Pran Goswami the President of the Governing Body of Bahona College. Dr P.K Dutta, Principal Bahona College, welcomed the gathering in his inaugural speech. The invited speaker and Guest of Honour, Dr. Girish Baruah, Retd. Associate Professor, DKD College, delivered his lecture on Critical Time: Assamese Community and National Values.
